HOUSE WINES

1. Sauvignon Blanc, Alta Baliza, 2016/17 £16.95
(Central Valley, Chile)

A refreshing young wine showing a green yellow colour. The aromas are fresh with hints of grass and citrus fruit. On the palate, balanced acidity light body and lingering finish. (1) 125% vol

2. Merlot, Alta Baliza, 2015/16 £16.95
(Central Valley, Chile)

An intense violet red colour. On the nose, aromas of mature fruits, red berries and some spiced notes. Rich in tannins with a medium body and has a mildly persistent finish. (C) 13% vol

WHITE WINES

3. Chenin Blanc, Lion Ridge, 2013/14 £19.95
(Western Cape, South Africa)

Leaps out of its skin with zesty lemon tropical freshness followed on by more rounded melon flavours. (3) 13% vol

4. Garganega-Pinot Grigio, San Alessandro, 2015/16 £19.95
(Venezie, Italy)

Light and delicate style with floral notes and a lime and sherbet touch. (2) 11.5% vol

5. Chardonnay, Urmeneta, 2015/16 £20.95
(Central Valley, Chile)

This intense Chardonnay shows aromas of peach and pineapple, plus a hint of banana that all blend perfectly with sweet notes of vanilla. (2) 13% vol

6. Chablis, Domaine Vignes Blanche, £34.9.5
Louis Moreau, 2015/16 (Burgundy, France)

Produced by Louis Moreau, this fresh, crisp Chardonnay has wonderful citrus and mineral notes with a nutty hint on the finish. (1) 12.5% vol

ROSÉ WINES

7. Mateus Rosé, NV, Estremadura, £19.95
(Portugal)

This pretty wine continues to hold a popular spot in the market, delivering the bright, semi-sweet fruit with its lightly festive bubbles. (3) 11% vol

RED WINES

8. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Riserva, £19.95
Tor del Colle, Botter, 2013/14 (Abruzzo, Italy)

Intense and concentrated on the nose with cherry flavours and notes of blackberries and liquorice. Dry and herbaceous on the palate, rounded and mouthfilling. (C) 13.5% vol

9. Merlot, 2015/16 £21.95
(Languedoc, France)

Intense ruby red with enticing aromas of red berries and spice. Rich, round on the palate with a smooth finish. (B) 13% vol

10. Shiraz, Huntersville, 2013/14 £22.95
(Swartland, South Africa)

Shiraz in the South African style - broad texture, juicy fruit with cassis and mint overtones - and with a drier European touch. (D) 14% vol

11. Malbec, Martin Fierro, Bodegas Bórbore, 2015/16 £25.95
(San Juan, Argentina)

Soft sweet tannins with red and black fruit flavours. An ideal partner to red meats, grilled pork and cheese. (C) 13% vol

12. Rioja Crianza, Cormoran, 2013/14 £27.95
(Rioja, Spain)

Dark cherry red. Clean with intense ripe fruit, liquorice and toasted notes. This wine is rich and rounded in the mouth with a lovely long finish. (C) 14% vol

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

13. Prosecco, Borgo Sanleo £27.95
(Italy)

Intense floral, fruity bouquet. A wonderfully fresh and well-balanced, appley palate with just a hint of delicate almond. (1) 11% vol

14. Moët & Chandon Brut Imperial, NV £69.00
(Champagne, France)

Possibly the most well known of all Champagnes worldwide. Classic, old fashioned style. (1) 12% vol

15. Prosecco 11% Vol 200ml £7.99
